High Tech Campus Eindhoven is the smartest square kilometre in Europe. More than 10,000 researchers, developers and entrepreneurs are working at over 140 companies and institutes on developing future technologies and products. They are part of a unique and vibrant ecosystem of established global brands, leading research institutes, fast growth enterprises, high-tech startups and service companies. Located at the heart of the Brainport region, Campus companies are responsible for nearly 40% of all Dutch patent applications.

The Campus helps companies accelerate their innovation by offering easy access to high tech facilities and international networks. Knowledge, experience, world class research facilities and technical infrastructure are shared in an Open Innovation ecosystem. The focus is on finding answers to the big global questions in Health, Energy and Smart Environments.

FACILITIES, EXPERTISE AND SERVICES

Cooperation is boosted by the collaborative and open research programmes of technology institutes such as Holst Centre, Solliance, EIT Digital, EIT KIC InnoEnergy and ITEA 3. Campus residents also have access to Philips Innovation Services with 25,000 square metres of multi-purpose labs and clean rooms, reliability testing, over 10,000 electronic instruments for hire plus a 3500 square metre pilot factory.

CENTRE OF KNOWLEDGE

The Campus is at the heart of the Brainport region Eindhoven, renowned for its high concentration of high-tech and knowledge intensive industry. The region provides more than 50,000 jobs in the high-tech, automotive, life sciences, food, (industrial) design and development industries. Global technology players like Intel, ABB, Philips, ASML, NXP, FEI Company, Canon, VDL Group and TomTom are based here.

GREAT PLACE TO WORK

The Campus hosts about 500 events per year, mostly technical conferences and business events, but also network meetings. The active hub of activities is The Strip, a 400-metre-long building, complete with restaurants and extensive conference facilities. It's the place to discuss, negotiate and inspire others. There are also several shops, a supermarket and Campus Wellness Center. In addition Campus Sports provides a whole range of indoor and outdoor sports activities.
